Falkirk Council is working alongside our partners in the Falkirk Health and Social Care Partnership to deliver Community Choices – a fund of over £3M over two years, where local communities apply for funding to bring about the changes that will make a real and lasting difference to YOUR community. Community Choices aims to support proposals that can make your area Fairer, Healthier, more Connected and more Inclusive.

Clubs, organisations, community groups and individuals from right across the Falkirk Council area have submitted proposals for funding to make these changes happen.

There are two Community Choices funds: a Small Grants Programme (up to £1,500) and a Place-based Capital Funding programme for larger projects (anything over £5,000).

- 3) Read about the proposals in your ward.
- 4) Vote for the proposals you want to see funded.


Small Grants proposals can be voted on from 24 May to 18 June.
